ASBOA Junior High Level A – N, DDDD, DDD, DD, 7E-7EEEE, 8E-8EEEE

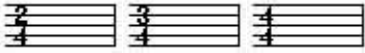
ASBOA Senior High Level A – N, D, DD, DDD, DDDD, 1A, 2AA

Maximum of one key change.

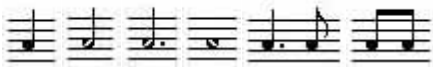
Meter:



Maximum of one meter change.

Rhythm:

Length:

Two and one-half (2 1/2) minutes or less.

Level II

ASBOA Junior High Level B – 9E-9EE

ASBOA Junior High Level C – 9EEE-9EEEE

ASBOA Senior High Level B – 3A

(9EEE-9EEEE and 3A play more of the selection)

Same criteria as Level I - EXCEPT:

Key:

Maximum of two (2) keys with a maximum of two (2) key changes

Level III

ASBOA Senior High Level C – 4A, 5A

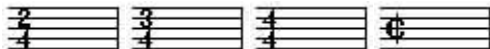
(5A plays more of the selection)

Key:

Concert F, B-flat, E-flat Major.

Maximum of two (2) keys with a maximum of two (2) key changes.

Meter:



Maximum of two (2) meters with a maximum of two (2) meter changes.

Rhythm:

BASIC PATTERNS



PERCUSSION ONLY



Length: Three (3) minutes or less.

Level IV

ASBOA SENIOR HIGH Level D – 6A, 7A

(7A plays more of the selection)

Same criteria as Level III - EXCEPT:

Add A-flat

Rhythm:

All sixteenths can be used for percussion AND wind players.
