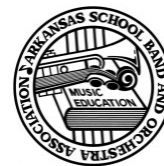

#### Carl A. Bly – Music Ensemble



Carl A. Bly, a native of Carbondale, PA, is a third-generation music educator. Mr. Bly has been involved in music education for 50 years. He was the band director at Lake Braddock Secondary School and Centreville High School in Fairfax County, VA, J. R. Tucker High School in Richmond, VA, was an adjunct assistant professor at Shenandoah Conservatory, and Concert Band and Orchestra Director at Georgetown University in Washington, DC.

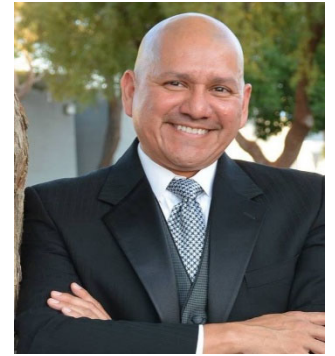
Mr. Bly received his Bachelor of Music Education degree from Shenandoah Conservatory of Music in Winchester, VA and a Master's in Conducting from George Mason University in Fairfax, VA. He has studied conducting with Anthony Maiello, Ret. Col. Arnold Gabriel of the United States Air Force Band, Jacque Houtmann of the Richmond Syerimphony, and Dr. Richard Lert and Samuel Jones at the Aman Symphony Orchestra League's Summer Conducting Institute. Mr. Bly's Concert and Marching Bands have enjoyed international reputations.

Recently Mr. Bly was inducted into the Virginia Band and Orchestra Directors Associations Hall of Fame, and the International Bandmasters Phi Beta Mu Hall of Fame.

Mr. Bly currently resides in Winchester, VA with his wife Randi Jean, and is the conductor of the Apple Valley Flute Choir. He maintains a busy schedule as guest lecturer, conducting and adjudicating throughout the United States. He has adjudicated for Drum Corps International, Bands of America, USBands, and concert festivals throughout the US and Canada.

## Jon Gomez – Music Effect

**Jon Gomez** serves as a National Educational Clinician providing services as a music educator, conductor, consultant, public speaker, and adjudicator. Mr. Gomez is the Former Director of Bands and Department Chair for the Performing Arts at Dobson High School in Mesa, Arizona (2000-2016). He received a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree and a Master's degree in Education Administration from Arizona State University. Bands under Gomez's leadership earned numerous accolades and have presented distinguished performances.



Jon Gomez is currently associated with The Midwest Clinic Advisory Committee, serves as a Bands of America judge and Conn-Selmer clinician. He is a Charter Member of the Kappa Zeta Chapter of Phi Beta Mu, the recipient of the Arizona State University School of Music Alumni Award, and the recipient of the AMEA O.M. Hartsell Excellence in Teaching Music Award. Jon has also served with the Arizona Band and Orchestra Directors Association as the Past President and Board Member, and as the Co-Founder of the Summer Marching Academy.

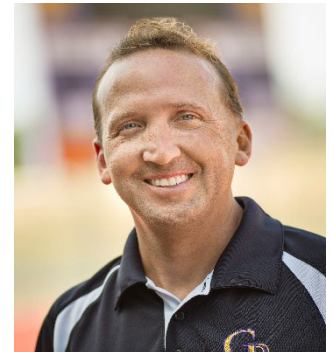
## Ken Turner – Music Effect



**Ken Turner** has extensive experience in music education and the marching Arts. He has served as band director, music supervisor, clinician, music arranger, program coordinator, adjudicator, and guest conductor for bands and drum corps throughout the United States, Canada, and Japan. His local, state, national, groups have won numerous and international honors. He was the Music and Brass caption Chairman for Drum Corps Associates, the New York Federation of Contest Judges, Drum Corps East and Drum Corps International, and he served as Judge Administrator and Chief Judge for the New York State Field Band Conference and Drum Corps International. Ken has been inducted into the Drum Corps International and the New York State Field Band Conference Halls of Fame. He served as Director of Music for the Johnson City Central School District in Johnson City, NY, which was honored on 7 occasions as a GRAMMY Signature School, and was recognized as one of the 100 Best Communities in America for Music Education. Ken served as a member of the national advisory board for the Partners in Education Program at the John F Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, and he is currently a member of NAMM's congressional advocacy group. He is on the board of directors for the Binghamton Philharmonic Orchestra and he holds a US Patent for the Angled Shell Marching Bass Drum and the Balanced Projection Drum Kit. Ken is the President and CEO of ErgoSonic Percussion LLC, ([www.ergosonicdrums.com](http://www.ergosonicdrums.com)), exclusive manufacturers of ErgoSonic drums.

## Dr. Tim Allshouse – Visual Effect

**Dr. Tim Allshouse**, is the Director of Bands at Blue Springs High School. During his tenure the Blue Springs Band has performed in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade three times, the Tournament of Concert and Jazz Bands have performed at the state music conference seven times in the last Roses Parade twice and the Presidential Inaugural Parade. The Blue Springs Marching Band has been a Bands of America Super Regional Finalist collectively 28 times in St. Louis, Indianapolis, Atlanta and San Antonio as well as a multi-time Grand National Finalist. The Blue Springs fourteen years. The jazz ensemble was the featured entertainment at the prestigious Tournament of Roses Presidential Breakfast as well as the National School Board Association and the SYTA Convention on two occasions. The Blue Springs Band Department is a recipient of the prestigious Sousa Foundation Award: The Sudler Shield and is recognized as a national Grammy Signature Music program.



Dr. Allshouse received his bachelor's degree from Indiana University in both instrumental and vocal music education where he studied conducting with Ray Cramer and Stephen W. Pratt. He received his masters from the University of Missouri and his doctorate from the University of Kansas. Dr. Allshouse serves on the national Advisory Committee for Music for All, serves as an adjudicator for Bands of America and is on the instructional staff for the 2022 Tournament of Roses Parade National Honor Band. Dr. Allshouse is active as an adjudicator, clinician, honor band conductor and drill designer. Dr. Allshouse enjoys spending time with his family and has found special joy experiencing music side-by-side with his daughters in the band program.

## Wayne Dillon – Visual Ensemble



**Wayne Dillon** holds a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts and Education from York University in Toronto, Canada, and a Master's degree in Jazz Performance/Pedagogy from The University of Miami, Florida. Wayne is the former Director of Bands at Elizabeth HS in NJ and was recently awarded the 2021 NJ Jazz Education Achievement Award. Wayne was also awarded the State of New Jersey Governor's Teacher Recognition Award for his work with the music program at Elizabeth High School.

Wayne was recently appointed as Chief Judge for Winter Guard International in the Winds division. He is also an adjudicator for Drum Corps International and Bands of America. He has judged the prestigious National Championships for all three organizations over the past thirty years. Currently, Wayne is serving as a music judge liaison for DCI, responsible for judge assignments and training. Additionally, he is an educational clinician for Conn-Selmer Music and travels the country working with diverse band programs.

Wayne formerly served as the Brass Caption Head for the Boston Crusaders Drum and Bugle Corps. He has also worked on the music staff of the ten-time World Champion -The Cadets, serving as the music supervisor in 2002. In 2010-2011, Wayne served as a staff member for the US Army All American Marching Band. Recently, Wayne was honored with his induction into The Buglers Hall of Fame in 2020.

Wayne has played trumpet with The Studio Jazz Band and the Art Blakey Jazz Ensemble from the University of Miami. As a performing recording artist, Wayne has played with the Clearwater Jazz Holiday Festival and Outreach program. He has also performed with KC and the Sunshine Band, Al Chez (from the Dave Letterman band), Jeff Healey and Albert Collins, Steve Brosky, The Meteors, Jay and the Technics, Don Mayer, Tower Suite, and The Hamilton Philharmonic.

**Chris Babashka** has been actively involved in the marching arts for more than 30 years; including 4 years marching in The Big Red Marching Machine at Illinois State University and 3 years with the Velvet Knights Drum and Bugle Corps from Anaheim, California.
