SECOND JAZZ BAND - JASON SMITH

A native of Calhoun, Louisiana, Mr. Smith brings a dynamic passion to trumpet and music education. Mr. Smith distinguished himself as a professional trumpet player with the United States Air Force Band. A valued asset to the military and the band career field for over ten years, Mr. Smith traveled to over 25 states and 5 international countries, touring as a lead trumpet player and soloist for various concert, rock, and big bands.

Mr. Smith's extensive knowledge of the big band genre led to his appointment as the musical director for the USAF Band of the West's "Dimensions in Blue." Under his musical leadership, his programming and drive towards a fresh, contemporary sound enhanced the ensemble's musical product to become comparable to the nation's finest big bands. Mr. Smith has also become a requested clinician among many high school and college level big bands and has taught privately through the Northside School District in San Antonio, Texas. He has performed with the renowned United States Air Force Band "Airmen of Note," the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra, and the San Antonio Symphony Orchestra, Dave Stall, Eddie Daniels, Eric Ewazen, Dwayne O' Brien, The Miracles, The Food Network, The International Trumpet Guild, The Dayton Jazz Orchestra, The San Antonio Jazz Orchestra, and The Vintage 15. Mr. Smith's musical talents can be heard on numerous musical recordings ranging from Big Band, Classical and Christian Worship.



Mr. Smith holds a BA in Jazz Studies and a Master of Music in Jazz Studies from The University of Arkansas at Monticello. He teaches trumpet and is the director of the prestigious Jazz One at the University of Arkansas at Monticello. Under his direction, Jazz One won the "Most Outstanding Big Band" award and seven individual student jazz awards at the Elmhurst Jazz Festival in 2019, recorded its first studio album called "The First Time Out," and performed at the 75th Annual Midwest Convention in Chicago, Illinois.

FIRST JAZZ BAND - ALAN BAYLOCK



Born and raised in a small town in Southwestern Pennsylvania, Alan Baylock has composed music that is performed throughout the world. One of the most respected and sought-after jazz composers and educators in the industry today, he is the director of the Grammy nominated One O'Clock Lab Band at the University of North Texas, and previously served 20 years as Chief Arranger for the USAF Airmen of Note in Washington, D.C., Composer-in-Residence, and the University of North Texas (M.M. '94). The Alan Baylock Jazz Orchestra recorded three critically-acclaimed CDs and performed throughout the United States for 15 years. Mr. Baylock graduated from Shenandoah University (B.M. '90), where he later became Jazz composer-in-residence and the University of North Texas (MM '94).

Baylock travels extensively as guest conductor and clinician, and has been featured with close to 100 professional, collegiate, high school (all-state and regional) and middle school jazz ensembles. Alan is on faculty at the National Jazz Workshop (NJW) and directed the NJW All-Star Big Band in performances on the East and West Coast. He is an active member of the Jazz Education Network and is a strong advocate for women in jazz. In 2022, Alan teamed up with composer/arranger Annie Booth to establish Brava Jazz Publishing, whose

mission it is to support and champion women composers and arrangers in the field of big band jazz by creating a platform for their music to be widely published and distributed. Baylock lives in Denton, Texas with his wife, cellist Maria Baylock. In his spare time, Alan enjoys playing table tennis, and golfing with his UNT Jazz colleagues.

TENOR/BASS CHOIR - KEN SIELOFF

Kenneth Sieloff is currently a graduate student at the University of North Texas where he is pursuing a master's degree in Choral Conducting. At UNT, Sieloff serves as the Conducting Associate for A Cappella Choir, assistant to the Director of Choral Studies, and choral librarian. Prior to UNT, Sieloff served as Director of Choirs at Permian High School in Odessa, Texas.

In his time at Permian HS, Mr. Sieloff's choirs performed at the 2018 Texas Music Educators Association Conference and the 2020 Southwestern ACDA Conference. In 2020, Permian HS Cantus (tenor-bass choir) was selected as National Winner in the Foundation for Music Education Mark of Excellence competition, and in 2021 they were winners of the American Prize in Choral Performance – High School Division. Ensembles under Mr. Sieloff's leadership have consistently earned "Best in Class" and superior ratings in concert and sightreading evaluations. In 2017 he was named a "Young Director of Distinction" by the Texas Choral Directors Association.

Along with his passion for working with young musicians in the classroom, Sieloff has long been dedicated to the art of conducting. In 2011 he competed in the American Choral Directors Association's National Student Conducting Competition in Chicago, IL and won first place. Sieloff enjoys serving as an active clinician and adjudicator throughout the state of Texas. From 2015-2020 Sieloff served as Artistic Director & Conductor of the Allegro Chorale in Midland-Odessa, TX where he implemented a thriving scholarship program for college students who sang with the ensemble. Notable performances with Allegro include Fern Hill by Corigliano, Chichester Psalms by Bernstein, Annelies by Whitbourn, and Aaron Copland's Appalachian Spring for chamber orchestra. Sieloff has appeared as guest conductor with The University of Texas of the Permian Basin Symphony Orchestra, and the



Appalachian Spring for chamber orchestra. Sieloff has appeared as guest conductor with The University of Texas of the Permian Basin Symphony Orchestra, and the Midland-Odessa Symphony Orchestra & Chorale. and in 2013 conducted a production of Stephen Sondheim's American opera Sweeney Todd at Odessa College which featured Metropolitan Opera Baritone Gary Simpson.

Sieloff holds a Bachelor of Music Education degree from The University of Michigan, where he studied voice. with Professor Martha Sheil and conducting with Eugene Rogers, Paul Rardin, and Jerry Blackstone. Ken loves to spend time with his wife Annie, daughter Charlotte, and dogs Lily and Sadie. He enjoys the great outdoors, including hunting, and spending time with friends whenever he has the chance.

TREBLE CHOIR - DR. JONI JENSEN



Dr. Joni Jensen is the Director of Choral Activities and Associate Professor of Voice at Texas Woman's University in Denton, TX. She conducts two TWU choirs and teaches voice and conducting. She received her Bachelor's degree in Vocal Performance and Pedagogy and her Master's degree in Choral Conducting from Brigham Young University in Provo, UT. She received her DMA in Choral Conducting, and minor in vocal performance at the University of Arizona. Dr. Jensen studied under renowned conductors and arrangers Dr. Mack Wilberg, Dr. Ronald Staheli, and Dr. Bruce Chamberlain.

Dr. Jensen has conducted numerous honor and festival choirs and serves as a choral clinician and adjudicator throughout the United States. She has most recently conducted all-state ensembles in Oklahoma, Colorado, Wisconsin, and Illinois. Under her direction, the TWU Concert Choir (treble chorus) has performed at the Southwest American Choral Directors Association (SWACDA) Conference, the National Collegiate Choral Association Conference (NCCO), the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) National Conference, and the Texas Music Educators' Association (TMEA) Conference.

Also busy as a composer/arranger, Dr. Jensen has several pieces published with Walton Music, including "El Vito," which is a popular all-state piece. She is also the editor of a series at Hal Leonard for advanced women's choral music and has many pieces published there as well. Recently, she was invited to serve on the ACDA Composition Initiatives Standing Committee. Dr. Jensen is also an Associate Dean and Musical Director of Millennial Choirs and Orchestras (MCO). MCO is a multi-location community organization, the largest of its kind in the world, and promotes the highest quality of sacred music for all ages. She conducts mainly in the Texas location. Their album "Millennial Song," released in in October 2019, peaked at #1 on the Classical Album Billboard Chart.Aside from her performing and teaching

Aside from her performing and teaching activities, Dr. Jensen has research interests in vocal pedagogy in the choral setting, choral conducting technique, baroque performance practice, women's choral literature, and choral arranging and composition.

SATB CHOIR - DR. JASON MAX FERDINAND

Dr. Ferdinand is currently Director of Choral Activities at the University of Maryland, School of Music. He most recently served at Oakwood University in Huntsville, AL, as professor of Music, Director of Choral Activities, and Chair of the Department of Music. He conducted the world-renowned Aeolians and is the author of the book, *Teaching with Heart: Tools for Addressing Societal Challenges Through Music*, published by GIA and the editor of The Jason Max Ferdinand Choral Series, available through Walton Music.

In 2017, he earned the Outstanding Director, and the Aeolians were awarded the coveted "Choir of the World" title at the Llangollen International Musical Festival, in Wales. In 2018, his choir won three gold medals at the 10th World Choir Games held in South Africa and won the competition's overall championship in both the Spirituals and University Choir categories. In 2018, he was named "Teacher of the Year" by Oakwood University. The Aeolians made their first appearance at the national conference of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) in 2019 and the term "they broke ACDA" was used to describe their outstanding presentation.

He is the founding director of the Jason Max Ferdinand Singers, which made their debut on the Voces8 concert series, *Live From London*. He maintains an active schedule as a guest conductor and lecturer at schools, universities, churches, and choral festivals and conferences, both domestic and international. Dr. Ferdinand holds degrees from Oakwood University, Morgan State University, and a doctorate in choral conducting from the University of Maryland.

Dr. Verena Mösenbichler-Bryant serves as Professor of the Practice of Music at Duke University, Director of the Duke University Wind Symphony, Director of Undergraduate Studies for the music department, and Artistic Director & Conductor of the Durham Medical Orchestra. Mösenbichler-Bryant is the Executive Director of the World Youth Wind Orchestra and World Adult Wind Orchestra Projects, both part of the annual Mid-Europe festival in Schladming, Austria (www.mideurope.at). She also co-founded and conducts the North Carolina Youth Wind Ensemble and is the newly appointed conductor of the Schwäbisches Jugendblasorchester. Verena grew up in Eberschwang, Austria. She began piano lessons at the age of 6, continuing later with Church organ, flute, and bassoon. Her conducting debut at age 16 was followed by a Kapellmeister Ausbildung with Johann Mösenbichler. Verena Mösenbichler-Bryant then studied symphony orchestra conducting with Ingo Ingensand at the Anton Bruckner Private University in Linz, Upper Austria. Dr. Mösenbichler-Bryant received her bachelor's degree, with distinction, in 2005. She completed her Master of Music in 2007 with Kevin Sedatole at Michigan State University, followed by a DMA in Wind Ensemble Conducting in May 2009, from The University of Texas at Austin with Jerry Junkin.

Verena Mösenbichler-Bryant's transcription of John Corigliano's Grammy-winning work, Mr. Tambourine Man, for Wind Ensemble and Amplified Soprano, published by G. Schirmer, was strongly praised by the composer, and has received numerous performances since its 2009 premiere. Additionally, she has arranged and premiered Eric Whitacre's *Goodnight Moon* for Soprano and Wind Ensemble and *Sing Gently*, available through Hal Leonard, and Steven Bryant's *all stars are love* for Soprano and Orchestra. She has also published an article in GIA's respected Teaching Music Through Performance in Band series. Verena

has served as guest conductor and clinician across the United States, Taiwan, Japan, Germany, Portugal, France, as well in her native Austria and is winner of The American Prize in Conducting, 2019-20, in the band/wind ensemble university division.

CONCERT BAND - DR. ALBERT NGUYEN

Dr. Nguyen is the Director of Bands and Head of the Conducting Area at the University of Memphis. His responsibilities include overseeing all aspects of the University Bands program, conducting the Wind Ensemble, leading the graduate wind conducting program, and serving as the Executive Director of the University of Memphis Summer at the Scheidt Program. Ensembles under Dr. Nguyen's direction have performed at the CBDNA Southern Regional Conference, the TNMEA All-State Conference, and Internationally in Austria and Italy. As a conductor and clinician, he has worked with ensembles and students throughout the United States, including the Mid-South as well as California, Florida, Indiana, Kentucky, New Mexico, New York, North Dakota, South Carolina, and Texas. For his contribution to the University of Memphis' educational, research, outreach, and service missions, Dr. Nguyen was a recipient of the First Tennessee Professorship.

Dr. Nguyen began his professional teaching career as the Director of Bands at Morrilton High School in Morrilton, AR. He holds the Bachelor of Arts Degree in Music Education from Arkansas Tech University and the Master of Music and Doctor of Musical Arts in wind conducting from The University of Texas at Austin. He is a member of Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, and serves the College Band Directors National Association as a member of the Diversity Committee.

Dr. Crain retired in 2000 after 44 years in public school music education. Since 2010, he has served as president of the Board of Directors of The Midwest Clinic International Band and Orchestra Conference that meets annually in Chicago, Illinois.

Crain graduated from Charlotte High School in 1952, attended Trinity University in San Antonio and received a master's degree from the University of North Texas. Mr. Crain was band director in Mercedes, Belton, Spring, and Westfield High Schools in Texas. The Belton High School Band performed in the Tournament of Roses Parade in 1974, and in 1980, the Spring High School Band performed at The Midwest Clinic in Chicago, Illinois under his direction. Bands he directed won awards with performances in Colorado, California, Louisiana, Florida and Virginia. In 1982, he became Director of Music Programs for the Spring Independent School District near Houston. During his tenure in Spring ISD the band programs won numerous awards in Texas and nationally.

Dr. Ambrose is in constant demand as a guest conductor and has performed on four continents. Recent engagements include performances in Australia, Canada, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Singapore, and Taiwan as well as across the United States. In 2016, Dr. Ambrose was invited to spend ten days on tour as a guest conductor with the United States Army Field Band. Ambrose is the only civilian in history to be invited to guest conduct a premiere American military band on tour. This engagement led to the formation of the National Chamber Winds, a professional wind dectet based in Washington, D.C. for which he is Founder and Music Director. Ambrose is also the Founder and Music Director of the Atlanta Chamber Winds and Ensemble ATL, ensembles comprising musicians from the Atlanta Symphony, Atlanta Opera, and Atlanta Ballet Orchestras.

Dr. Ambrose is Founder and Principal Guest Conductor of the Metropolitan Atlanta Youth Wind Ensemble (MAYWE), a highly-select high school honor ensemble consisting of musicians from throughout the Atlanta area. During his nine-year tenure as Music Director, nearly 1000 high school students participated in the MAYWE program and the ensemble was invited to perform at Carnegie Hall on



Dr. Ambrose has strong ties to the Finnish music community. He is frequently engaged in that country as a guest conductor, teacher, master clinician, and lecturer. Recent guest conducting appearances include the Finnish Navy Band, the Helsinki Police Band, the STM Summer Music Festival Wind Orchestra, the Rauma Wind Band, and the youth wind bands of Kokkola, Kotka, and Rauma. He has taught conducting workshops in Tampere, Rauma, Kuopio, and Kokkola, and has served as a guest lecturer at the Central Ostrobothnian Conservatory and the Sibelius Academy. Ambrose is a prolific arranger with nearly two dozen publications to his credit. His transcriptions and editions are published by Presser Music, Murphy Music Press, C. Alan Publications, Fennica Gehrman (Finland), and Edition Tilli (Finland). His transcriptions appear on several state lists and have been performed around the world.
