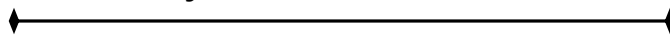

## LARRY PANELLA – JAZZ SECOND BAND



**Larry Panella** serves on the faculty of The University of Southern Mississippi as an associate professor of music and director of the jazz studies program and is the founder and leader of the USM Jazz Quartet (JQ). He has performed with numerous artists and entertainers, including the Phil Collins Big Band, the Woody Herman Orchestra, Natalie Cole, Steve Allen, Nelson Riddle and Frank Sinatra, Jr. His recordings include his newly released jazz quartet compact disc *Under the Influence*, two albums with the Collection Jazz Orchestra, two with the Ashley Alexander Big Band, and the recent compact disc release by the Phil Collins Big Band--*A Hot Night in Paris*. He received his master of music from Northern Illinois University and his bachelor of music from the University of North Texas, where he toured and performed as a member of the famed 1 o'clock Jazz Lab Band. Before his appointment at Southern Miss, Mr. Panella served on the faculty of Wheaton College Conservatory and Northern Illinois University School of Music. Mr. Panella is an artist - clinician for Cannonball Musical Instruments and also performs with the Southwest Horns.

## JEFF JARVIS – JAZZ FIRST BAND



**Jeff Jarvis** has distinguished himself as a trumpeter, composer, jazz educator, and music publisher. He serves as Director of Jazz Studies at California State University Long Beach and frequently appears as a honors jazz band conductor, clinician and lecturer. Jeff is the Music Director Emeritus of the Central New York Jazz Orchestra, serves as jazz coordinator for the Texas Bandmasters Association, and is a former Vice-President of the International Association For Jazz Education. Jeff is part-owner of Kendor Music, Inc., the first educational music publisher to provide jazz charts written especially for students. His solo recordings as a jazz trumpeter and composer have placed high on national air play charts and have won him critical acclaim. Jeff's early career as a studio trumpeter encompasses over 100 albums for such names as Lou Rawls, Melba Moore, The O'Jays and many more. Live performance credits include Dizzy Gillespie, Louie Bellson, Joe Williams, Benny Golson, Jon Hendricks, Jimmy Heath, Joe Lovano, Henry Mancini, Slide Hampton, Kevin Mahogany, Grady Tate, Eddie Daniels, Rob McConnell, and Doc Severinsen. A Yamaha trumpet artist, Jeff has performed throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia and Indonesia. He has most recently been featured with the USAF Airmen of Note, Syracuse Symphony Orchestra, Dallas Jazz Orchestra, US Army Jazz Ambassadors, Jazz Knights of the United States Military Academy Band at West Point, Riverside Jazz Orchestra, Oslo Big Band (Norway), US Army Blues, Frank Mantooth Jazz Orchestra, Denver Symphony Orchestra, USAF Shades of Blue and more.

## ROBERT BALDWIN - ORCHESTRA



**Robert Baldwin** is Director of Orchestral Activities at the University of Utah. He is also Music Director of the Salt Lake Symphony and conductor of "It's a Grand Night for Singing," in Lexington, Kentucky. During his tenure at the University of Utah, the orchestral program has grown dramatically in size and quality, with noted performances at the 2003 Utah Arts Festival, the 2005 Utah Music Educators' Association Conference, and a tour of Austria for the 2006 Mozart Orchestra Festival. He has previously held conducting positions with the University of Kentucky, Lexington Philharmonic, New American Symphony, Northern Arizona University, and Flagstaff Symphony orchestras. Also an accomplished violist, Baldwin has held several positions, including professor of viola at Northern Arizona University and principal viola with the Arkansas Symphony, Flagstaff Symphony, and Arizona Opera Orchestras. In 1998, Dr. Baldwin had his European conducting debut with the Hermitage Camerata in Saint Petersburg, Russia. He will conduct in Finland, New York City, and Louisville, Kentucky during the 2008-09 season. Other recent guest conducting appearances include the Lexington Philharmonic, Flagstaff Festival of the Arts, Colorado State University, the Abilene Tri-Collegiate Opera, and numerous festivals and All-State Orchestras around the country. His performances and ensembles have been featured on National Public Radio's Performance

Today and Weekend Edition, as well as in the New Yorker magazine. As a violist, experiences include guest appearances with the Amadeus Trio, and the Saint Petersburg and Stanford String Quartets. He has appeared as a soloist with the Flagstaff Symphony, SMU Festival Orchestra, and Sedona Chamber Music Festival. He was violist of the Arizona-based Coconino Chamber Ensemble from 1989-1999. Recent appearances include recitals in the US and Mexico, and performances with the University Faculty Chamber Players, the Utah Chamber Artists and the Utah Symphony. Dr. Baldwin has studied in the United States and in Saint Petersburg, Russia. His wife, Maria, teaches viola privately and also teaches Kindermusik classes in the Salt Lake Valley. His two children, Daren (10) and Alyssa (7) study cello and viola, respectively.

## GREGORY WOLYNEC – CONCERT BAND

**Gregory Wolynec** is the Director of Bands and an Assistant Professor of Music at Austin Peay State University where he directs the Wind Ensemble and teaches undergraduate and graduate conducting. In addition, Dr. Wolynec teaches courses in orchestration and instrumental music education. Prior to coming to Austin Peay he held a similar position at Castleton State College in Vermont. Dr. Wolynec received his MM and DMA degrees in Instrumental Conducting from Michigan State University and a BM in Music Education and Clarinet Performance from SUNY Potsdam's Crane School of Music. Dr. Wolynec has taken additional studies in conducting at the Prague Conservatory, Czech Republic. His conducting teachers have included John Whitwell and Timothy Topolewski. Dr. Wolynec completed his doctoral dissertation, *The Original Works for Harmonie Ensemble of Johann Nepomuk Went*, as the recipient of both a Fulbright Grant to Prague, Czech Republic and a Michigan State University Graduate Merit Fellowship. His research was carried out throughout the Czech Republic, Austria, Germany and France. Dr. Wolynec has taught in the public schools of New York where his ensembles were routinely awarded Gold ratings at New York State Major Ensemble Festivals and performed on trips to major cities in the northeast. As a graduate assistant to MSU Bands he directed the Concert and Campus Bands, taught advanced conducting and guest conducted the Wind Symphony, Symphony Band and Chamber Winds. In addition, he was an arranger and instructor for the Spartan Marching Band and Spartan Brass. Dr. Wolynec has been an active clinician and guest conductor of bands and orchestras in New York, New England, Michigan, Tennessee and Kentucky.



## ROBERT W. RUMBELOW – SYMPHONIC BAND

**Robert W. Rumbelow** is in his twelfth year as Conductor and Director of Wind Ensemble Activities in the Schwob School of Music at Columbus State University. In addition to teaching classes in conducting and literature, he is the conductor of the faculty Camerata chamber orchestra and frequent conductor of opera productions. Dr. Rumbelow previously served as the associate conductor of the famed Eastman Wind Ensemble and Eastman Wind Orchestra. He also worked with the Eastman Studio Orchestra, Kilbourn Orchestra, Musica Nova, and the independent Rochester Chamber Players. Rumbelow received his Doctor of Musical Arts degree in conducting from Eastman and primarily studied with Donald Hunsberger. Prior to his doctoral studies at Eastman, he successfully served as a director of bands in the Texas public schools. Rumbelow maintains a very active schedule as a guest conductor, clinician, arranger, composer, and lecturer. He is the recipient of several notable accolades, including being a two-time winner of the Walter Hagen Conducting Prize, the first prize winner in the Sir Georg Solti International Conducting Competition sponsored by the Sousa Foundation, winner of the North American round of the Tokyo International Conducting Competition (conducting the San Francisco Opera Orchestra), and progressing to the finals in Tokyo (conducting the Tokyo Philharmonic and the Shinsei Symphony Orchestra). Rumbelow is in demand throughout the United States, Canada, Japan, and Europe as a conductor for both wind bands and orchestras. His Russian debut conducting the Hermitage State Chamber Orchestra in April of 2003 received critical praise. Outstanding performances of the CSU Wind Ensemble under the baton of Dr. Rumbelow have been recorded and broadcast on NPR and Georgia Public Broadcasting. Recordings on the Summit label as well as performances by the ensemble at statewide and national conferences have brought widespread praise for the wind ensemble program. Most recently, recording projects with New York Philharmonic principal trombonist Joseph Alessi, and Chicago Symphony co-principal clarinetist John Bruce Yeh will soon be released internationally.



## GARY HILL – WIND SYMPHONY

**Gary W. Hill** is Professor of Music and Director of Bands at Arizona State University where he conducts the Wind Symphony and the Chamber Winds, teaches graduate conducting, and is founder of the Digital Conducting Laboratory.

Prior to Hill's appointment at ASU, he was Director of Bands at the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music, where he also served as Music Director for the Kansas City Youth Wind Ensemble, and conducted two professional groups: the Kansas City Symphony Brass Ensemble and newEar, a chamber ensemble devoted to contemporary music. Previously, he held a similar post at East Texas State University and was Associate Director of Bands at the University of Colorado, Boulder. Hill began his teaching career in Michigan where he served as Director of Bands for the West Bloomfield and Traverse City public schools. High school, university, and professional ensembles under Hill's direction have given performances for the National Band Association, the Music Educators National Conference, the College Band Directors National Association, the American Bandmasters Association, the International Horn Symposium, the National Flute Association, at many state conventions, and throughout North America, and Europe. Performances conducted by him have consistently drawn praise from composers, performing musicians, and critics alike for their insightful, inspired, and cohesive realizations, and for their imaginative programming. As a guest conductor and clinician, appearances in more than a dozen countries and throughout most of the United States have included performances with myriad high school honor bands, numerous college and university wind bands and orchestras, at the Midwest International Band and Orchestra Clinic, and at World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles' conferences. Additionally, he is in constant demand as a conducting teacher and as a clinician for bands and orchestras. Hill's current research is two-fold: he is engaged in an ongoing investigation of digital technologies applicable to the conducting classroom, with an emphasis on motion capture technology; and he is writing a book on the past, present, and future of wind band.



## DAVID L. BRUNER – MALE CHORUS



**David L. Brunner** is acclaimed as a dynamic conductor, inspired teacher and imaginative composer. His wide and varied expertise embraces all ages in professional, university, public school, community, church and children's choruses. Dr. Brunner is Professor Music and Director of Choral Activities at the University of Central Florida, where he conducts the University Chorus and Madrigal Singers, teaches courses in conducting and music education, and coaches private composition students. In both 1995 and 2000 he received a College of Arts and Sciences Excellence in Undergraduate Teaching Award and in 1995 the University Excellence in Teaching Award, UCF's highest teaching honor. He is also the recipient of the College of Arts and Sciences Distinguished Researcher Award (2005), a Research Incentive Award (2002) and three Teaching Incentive Awards (2005, 1996 and 1993). In 1996 he received a National Award for College Teaching from the Center for the Advancement of Teaching and Learning. He has been Artistic Director and Conductor of Gloria Musicae, Florida's professional chamber chorus; Guest Conductor of the Master Chorale of Tampa Bay, the Principal Chorus of the

Florida Orchestra; and Music Director of the Florida Ambassadors of Music, with which he conducted six European concert tours. Other European appearances include performances at the Seminar fur Klassische Musik at the Eisenstadter Sommerakademie in Eisenstadt and Vienna, Austria; in St. Mark's Basilica, Venice; at St. Martin-in-the-Fields and Wesley's Chapel, London; and at the Vatican for Pope John Paul II. His choirs have appeared at state and divisional conventions of both the American Choral Directors Association and the Music Educators National Conference. He has, on three occasions, conducted concerts of his works for chorus and orchestra at Carnegie Hall.

## LISA FREDENBURGH – FEMALE CHORUS



**Lisa Fredenburgh** has been Director of Choral Activities at Meredith College in Raleigh, NC since 1996 where she conducts choirs and teaches courses in conducting, and secondary choral music education. She holds a DMA and two M.M degrees from the University of Arizona where she studied under Maurice Skones, Josef Knott, Thomas Hilbish, Jerry McCoy and Kenneth Jennings. Her BA in music education was earned at Luther College, under Weston Noble. Fredenburgh often serves as guest conductor and clinician locally, nationally, and abroad. She has conducted and taught masterclasses in the Dominican Republic and in Bolivia. She is a frequent presenter at national, regional and state level professional organizations in the fields of Women's Choral Music, and the Music of Latin America. She formerly served as National Chair for the Women's Choir Repertoire & Standards Committee for the American Choral Directors Association and currently serves on the steering committee for the 50th Anniversary National Convention in 2009. She is a member of CMS, MENC, and Society for Ethnomusicology.

## DR. DONALD BAILEY – MIXED CHORUS



**Dr. Donald Bailey** is the Director of Choral Activities and the Mary Gibbs Jones Professor of Music at Baylor University where he conducts the A Cappella Choir, Chamber Singers, and teaches choral conducting. He is also the music director and conductor the Schola Cantorum of Texas. His choirs have appeared with the Rochester (NY) Philharmonic Orchestra, the Buffalo (NY) Philharmonic, the Phoenix (AZ) Symphony Orchestra, the El Paso (TX) Symphony Orchestra, the Lubbock (TX) Symphony Orchestra, and the Orchestra of Santa Fe (NM). His choirs have sung three times for the American Choral Directors Association National Convention as well as for the Texas Music Educators Association, the New York State School Music Association, the Arizona Music Educators Association, and the Music Educators National Conference. He currently serves as the Music Director/Conductor of Schola Cantorum of Texas. Prior to coming to Baylor University in 1993, he held similar positions at Arizona State University, Texas Tech University, Houghton College, and Eastern New Mexico University. He received his Bachelor of Music Education summa cum laude and Master of Arts in Vocal Performance degrees from Eastern New Mexico University and his Doctor of Arts in Conducting from the University of Northern Colorado. Dr. Bailey was named an "Outstanding Alumnus" by the University of Northern Colorado for his contributions to music.

Particularly active as a guest conductor and clinician, he has conducted over three hundred and fifty clinics in the last ten years. He frequently appears as an All State Clinician having conducted All State Choirs in Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Montana, New Mexico, New York, Tennessee, and Texas. He has appeared as a guest conductor at both Carnegie Hall and Avery Fisher Hall in Lincoln Center. An active composer, Dr. Bailey is represented by Alliance Music Publications and Gentry Publications.
