Richard Saucedo- Music Ensemble & Chief Judge




Richard L. Saucedo (Fishers, Indiana) retired in 2013 as Director of Bands and Performing Arts Department Chairman at the William H. Duke Center for the Performing Arts at Carmel High School in Carmel, Indiana. During his 31-year tenure, Carmel bands received numerous state, regional, and national honors in concert, jazz, and marching bands. Under his direction, Carmel's Wind Symphony I performed at the Music for All National Concert Band Festival three times (1992, 1999, and 2004) and was named the Indiana State Champion Concert Band most recently in 2013. The group also performed at the Midwest Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago in December 2005. The Carmel Marching Greyhounds finished in the top ten at the Bands of America Grand National Championship for 17 years under Saucedo. They were

named BOA National Champions in the fall of 2005. Carmel became one of the few schools to win a BOA National Championship and perform at the Midwest Clinic in the same year in 2005. The Marching Band was the Indiana Class A State Champion four times. The Indiana Bandmasters Association named Saucedo Indiana's "Bandmaster of the Year" for 1998-99, and he was named the "Outstanding Music Educator" in Indiana for 2010 by the Indiana Music Educators Association. Saucedo was inducted into the Music for All "Hall of Fame" in 2015 and recently was inducted into the Drum Corps International "Hall of Fame" (2022).

Saucedo is a freelance arranger and composer. Along with his work at Hal Leonard Publishing, he is the music ensemble coordinator for the Blue Devils Drum and Bugle Corps in Concord, California. He is the Brass Arranger/Composer for the Cavaliers Drum and Bugle Corps in Rosemont, Illinois. Saucedo is an Educational Consultant for "Music for All" and "Bands of America." He currently serves as the Chief Judge-Team Leader for Bands of America marching band competitions.

Keith Bearden – Music Effect

Professor Bearden earned his bachelor and master degrees from Texas Tech University. After only one year of teaching, he served our country in the United States Air Force and played trumpet in the USAF Academy Band and Falconaires. Following completion of military service, he enjoyed six successful years of public-school teaching in Albany, and at Lubbock Monterey. In 1979 he was honored by Phi Beta Mu as Texas' Outstanding Young Bandmaster. In 1980 he was appointed associate director of bands and director of the Goin' Band from Raiderland" at Texas Tech University.



During his distinguished tenure at Texas Tech University, Professor Bearden was honored as Outstanding Faculty Member by Omicron Delta Kappa and Mortar Board. In 1999 his Goin' Band from Raiderland received the Sudler Trophy presented by the John Philip Sousa Foundation.

Other honors include the Kappa Kappa Psi Distinguished Service to Music Medal, Texas Tech's Department of Residence Life's Professing Excellence Award, the Lubbock Independent School District's Meritorious Service Award, the Texas Tech Committed of Champions Meritorious Service Award, The Goin' Band Alumni Ken Porter Service Award, the Texas Tech Alumni Association's Distinguished Service Award, and the Texas Tech School of Music's Distinguished Alumni Award. He has also received the Texas Bandmasters Lifetime Meritorious Achievement Award. Professor Bearden retired from Texas Tech University in May 2003 after 34 years of teaching, with 23 of those years being at Tech. In 2013, he was inducted into the Texas Bandmasters Hall of Fame. Professor Bearden was recipient of the Al G. Wright award at the 2019 Midwest Clinic/Convention in Chicago from the Women Band Director's International for his "honoring and continued support of women band directors over a long period of time". In 2021, he was named Texas "Bandmaster of the Year".

Professor Bearden is currently the executive secretary for both UIL Region 16 and Area A. He is the immediate past president of Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity, Phi Beta Mu Alpha chapter (Texas), and the Texas Music Adjudicators Association. Outside of music, Professor Bearden enjoys family, golf, camping and classic cars. His wife, June, is a retired middle school band director. They are members of Westminster Presbyterian Church in Lubbock. They have two sons and four grandchildren, one of which is a band director in the Houston area.

John Miller - Music Effect

Roce

John Miller recently retired as the Director of Bands at American Fork High School, American Fork, Utah, where he taught for 30 years. The American Fork Bands have received many honors under his direction, including performing in the Fiesta Bowl, twice in the Pasadena Tournament of Roses Parade, twice in the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in New York City, a finalist and six times semi-finalist at the Bands of America National Marching Band Championships, the 2005 Presidential Inaugural Parade in Washington DC and has placed first in the Bands of America Western Regionals nine times. His Wind Symphony has performed in the Music for All National Concert Band Festival.

Mr. Miller was selected twice as Teacher of The Year for the Alpine School District, received ten Citations of Excellence from the National Band Association, and twice received the Outstanding Music Educator Award from the National Federation of High School Activities Association for the Western States. He received the Sorenson "Lifetime Achievement in Arts Education" Award, the National Band Association National Blue Ribbon Award for a complete and balanced long-term Band Program, and the Band World's "Legion of Honor." In 2017, Mr. Miller was inducted into the Music for All "Hall of Fame" and in 2021 was inducted into the Utah Music Educators Association "Hall of Fame."

Holding a Master's degree in Music Education from Brigham Young University, he is the past Band Vice-President of the Utah Music Educators. He currently is an Adjunct-Professor at Brigham Young University and Utah Valley University, working in Music Education. He is past chair of the National Association for Music Education (NAfME) Band Council, past chair of the NBA Band Council, Marching Band Competition Coordinator and Chair for UMEA, Executive Director of the Western Regional "Music for All" Concert Band Festival, and he is the Executive Director of the Wasatch Music Alliance, and is currently the director of the Wasatch Winds Symphonic Band and the Wasatch Show Band.

Tim Ochran – Visual Ensemble

Tim Ochran has been active in the competitive marching music activity for over 40 years as an instructor, designer, program coordinator and adjudicator throughout the United States, Europe and Asia. As an active Bands of America judge since 1985 he has been involved in over 20 Grand National Championships, as well as serving as a member of the board of directors of Music for All. As an active DCI judge since 1993 he has also served as a visual judge liaison and visual judge coordinator. Away from the "activity" he and his wife Rhonda live on the Emerald Coast of Florida in Grayton Beach with their dachshund - MAX.

Todd James is an Oklahoma City based adjudicator, clinician, and entrepreneur that brings focus and energy to those he serves and works with. Todd holds bachelor's degrees from Texas State University in Music and Education. He has served as the Director of Musical Theater at South Texas' premiere Fine Arts High School, Northeast School of the Arts (NESA), in San Antonio, Texas. Under his artistic and musical direction, his all-encompassing musical theater productions were selected not only for both Texas and National Thespian Convention Performances, but for The Edinburgh Fringe Festival – known as one of the greatest celebrations of arts and culture on the

planet in Edinburgh, Scotland. Todd is also no stranger to the stage and camera as an active performing artist himself. Reality television fans may know him from Toddlers and Tiaras!

When not inspiring those in the Arts, he is the owner of Thompson's Creations in Oklahoma City, a Specialty Fabric Showroom.
