



The Delta Youth Symphony Orchestra was created in 2023 and is open to young musicians ages 12 to 18. No-cost auditions are held each semester and tuition waivers are available for those in financial need.

#### Summer String Camp

The DSO Summer String Camp is an annual week-long day camp for young string musicians ages 8 to 15.

The DSO began a national Young Artist Concerto Competition in 1988. Each year, talented, young musicians up to age 26 from across the United States travel to Jonesboro for a chance to compete for cash prizes in five music divisions: piano, strings, woodwinds, brass/percussion, and voice. 


