# Set I Senior High Jazz Audition Errata for Jazz Conception by Jim Snidero

# Alto/Baritone Saxophone Edits in Autumn Etude -

 Pg. 31, M42 - Beats 2 and 4 should have a marcato accent (A and C), Beat 3 should have a tenuto marking (B). These articulations should align with the books for other instruments.

### Tenor Saxophone Edits in Autumn Etude -

• Pg. 30, M4 of Chorus 1 (3rd line on the page after Intro) - The marcato accent on the F# played on the "and of 1" should not be present and is a misprint. It should align with the articulation present in the books for the other instruments and be blown through with normal legato swing articulation.

#### **Trombone Edits in Autumn Etude -**

• Pg. 31, M55 - The E Natural on beat 3 should be changed to an E-flat to reflect the key and offset the leading tone (E Natural) on beat 4.

#### Trombone Edits in Bird Blues Etude -

 Pg. 42, M17 - E Natural should be changed to an E-flat on the "and of 1" and "downbeat of 4" to reflect the F7 chord structure. This should mirror the notation in measure 5.

# Set III Senior High Jazz Audition Errata for Vol. 54 - Maiden Voyage by Aebersold

#### Bass Clef Instruments - Tenor Trombone, Bass Trombone, Bass

 Pg. 49, Impressions - All instruments should play the version written at the top of the page. <u>The "Higher Version" should not be used</u> since it is not an appropriate range for all instruments involved.

# <u>Sets I, II, and III Senior High Tenor Trombone Jazz Audition Errata for Jazz Conception by Jim Snidero</u>

• All etudes in the Jazz Conception book by Jim Snidero for tenor trombone should play the pitches as written (Set I, Autumn & Bird Blues, Set II, IND Line & Joe's Thing, Set III Friends & Total Blues). Students should NOT play 8va as suggested or referenced in the books. This will allow for a proper flow of range throughout each of the etudes and not an overuse of the high register.

# Set III Senior High Piano Jazz Audition Errata for Jazz Conception by Jim Snidero

- In the *Friends* piano comping etude, there are four instances of chord voicings that do not reflect what is played in the recording and individual notes should be adjusted accordingly: P.62 m.6, the chord on the "&" of beat four: B natural should be changed to **Bb** in the fourth voice from the top of the voicing.
- P.62 m.24, the chord on the "&" of beat four tied to beat one of m.25: the highest voice in the left hand should be changed from B natural to **Bb**.
- P.63 m.48, the chord on the downbeat of 3: the bass note should be changed from E natural to **Eb.**
- P. 63 m.55, the chord on the "&" of beat four tied to beat one in m.56: the top voice in right hand should be changed from D natural to **Db**.
