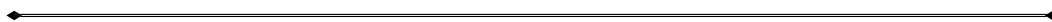

Ken Turner – Music Ensemble & Chief Judge



Ken Turner has an extensive background in music education and the marching arts. He served as Band Director at Tioga Central Schools and was the Band Director and Director of Music for the Johnson City School District, where his bands won numerous local, state and national awards, and where the music program was recognized on several occasions as a Grammy Signature School, and also named one of the 100 Best Schools (Communities) in America for Music Education.

He has served as music arranger, program coordinator, instructor and consultant for many well known bands and drum corps, including The Southern Tier Grenadiers, Empire State Express, Etobicoke-Oakland Crusaders, Empire Statesmen, Syracuse Brigadiers, Bayonne Bridgemen and Phantom Regiment Drum Corps, and the New Hartford, Johnson City, Jamestown and Green Valley Marching Bands, among others. He has served as an adjudicator and clinician at numerous local, state and national Concert Band, Percussion, Marching Band and Drum Corps events in the United States, Canada and Japan and is an adjudicator for Bands of America and US Bands. Ken was Music and Brass Caption Chairman for Drum Corps Associates (DCA), the New York Federation of Contest Judges and Drum Corps International (DCI), and served as a member of the DCI Task Force and the DCI 2000 Strategic Planning Committee. He was Chief Judge and Judge Administrator for the New York State Field Band Conference and Drum Corps International, and has been inducted into the New York State Field Band Conference Hall of Fame and the DCI Hall of Fame. Ken was a member of the National Advisory Board for the Partners in Education Program at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, and served on the National Association of Music Merchants (NAMM) congressional advocacy group. He holds a US patent for the angled shell drum kit and marching percussion instruments and is the President and CEO of ErgoSonic Percussion LLC. (www.ErgoSonicDrums.com) Ken serves on the board of directors for the Binghamton Philharmonic Orchestra, recipients of the 2025 American Prize for Orchestra. He and his wife, Suzanne, currently live in Apalachin, New York.

Jo Ann Hood – Music Effect

Jo Ann Hood began her teaching career in 1972 serving as Band Director at Giles County High School, Wright Jr. High School, Bellevue Jr. and Sr. High Schools, and Hillwood High School. She retired in 2011 after 30 years as Director of the John Overton High School Band in Nashville, TN. Miss Hood is Past President of TMEA, TBA, MTSBOA, and Phi Beta Mu. She has served as State Chair, High School Representative, and Southern Division Chair for the National Band Association. She has served as All State General Chair, All State Band Chair, and Exhibits Chairperson for TMEA. She currently serves on The Jury for the John Philip Sousa Foundation Sudler Shield and was on the staff for the 2010 and 2011 US Army All American Marching Band. She is a six-time recipient of the National Band Association's Certificate of Merit for Marching Excellence and a four-time recipient of the National Band Association's Citation of Excellence. She has been selected as an Outstanding Young Woman of America, Who's Who Among American Teachers, and Who's Who of American Women.



She was awarded the Scroll of Excellence for Outstanding Contributions to Bands and Band Music by the Women Band Directors National Association, is a two-time recipient of the John Philip Sousa Sudler Shield, a 2020 recipient of the MTSU Distinguished Alumni Award, a 2022 recipient of the NBA Mentor Award, and a 2024 recipient of the TMEA Service Award. Miss Hood has been inducted into the MTSU Band of Blue Club Hall of Fame, the National High School Band Directors Hall of Fame, the Tennessee Music Education Association Hall of Fame, and the Tennessee Bandmasters Association Hall of Fame. She holds membership in NAFME, TMEA, MTSBOA, NEA, TEA, MNEA, NBA, TBA, ASBDA, Delta Omicron, Kappa Delta Pi, and Phi Beta Mu. Since her retirement, Miss Hood has served as adjunct faculty at Middle Tennessee State University and Tennessee State University supervising music student teachers and worked with the MNPS Side By Side mentoring program. She serves extensively as an adjudicator and clinician of marching and concert bands.

Joel Denton – Music Effect



Joel L. Denton served as Director of Bands at Ooltewah High School for thirty-seven years before retiring in 2018. Mr. Denton is a graduate of the University of Tennessee and has completed graduate studies at UT-Chattanooga. Mr. Denton served at Lee University from 2021-2024 as an Adjunct Professor of Instrumental Music Education and Interim Conductor of the Wind Ensemble. Prior to his retirement, he was recognized in 2018 as a CMA Music Teacher of Excellence. At the 2015 Midwest Clinic, Mr. Denton was awarded the John Phillip Sousa Foundation Legion of Honor for his contributions to band. Under his direction, the Ooltewah Band achieved a national reputation for musical excellence including performances in the 2017 Tournament of Roses Parade, the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade in 2013 and 2007, and as the only band in the 2011 Disney Christmas Parade on ABC. The Ooltewah Marching Band was a consistent finalist at Bands of America Regional Championships being awarded multiple class championships and placements, and was a national semi-finalist on multiple occasions with several class placements. Under Mr. Denton's direction, the Ooltewah Concert Bands performed at the Music for All Southeast Regional Concert Festival in 2016, the TMEA (TN) State Music Conference in 2014 and 2010, the Smoky Mountain Music Festival in 2011 (Grand Concert Division Champions), and multiple other state, regional and national events through the years. He served as Chairman of Fine Arts at Ooltewah from 1982 until his retirement and was selected five times as the Ooltewah Teacher of the Year. The Tennessee Governor's School for the Arts has thrice honored him. His professional affiliations include the Tennessee Music Education Association (Mr. Denton currently serves as President of the association), East Tennessee School Band and Orchestra Association (he is a Past-President and Hall of Fame Member), Phi Beta Mu (he currently serves as Past-President of the ETA Chapter), National Band Association, American School Band Director Association, and Tennessee Bandmasters Association (he is a Past President and Hall of Fame Member). Mr. Denton served for eight years as the Tennessee State Chair for the National Band Association and served as a member of the Tennessee Department of Education's Fine Arts Student Growth Committee. He is active as an adjudicator, clinician, and consultant working with Music for All/Bands of America, Drum Corps International, several universities and state organizations, as well as, many high school bands across the nation. Through his corporation, Leading the Way, Inc., Mr. Denton presents clinics and provides consultations and professional development sessions across the nation and also works with band programs and other organizations on developing leadership and teambuilding skills. Mr. Denton and Kerry, his wife, reside in Chattanooga, Tennessee and have two adult children, Alex and Caroline, who are both educators.

Lee Carlson – Visual Ensemble

Lee Carlson has been involved in the pageantry arts for over 50 years. He has spent the last 42 years as the drill designer and color guard instructor for the University of Southern California Trojan Marching Band. His high school teaching experience includes 18 years at Indio High, Indio, CA. He has taught and written drill for many high schools including four years with Kamehameha High School in Honolulu, HI. He has instructed the Denver Blue Knights, Great Bend Argonne Rebels, and the Hutchinson Sky Ryders.



He has been a judge for Drum Corps International, Bands of America, Winter Guard International and many Winter Guard and Marching Band Circuits across the United States. With Drum Corps International he has served 21 years as a judge, four years as Visual Caption Head, five years as Judges Training Coordinator and for the past eight years has served in the position of Artistic Director and Director of Competition. He has judged in Europe and Asia and has adjudicated the Drum Corps Japan Championships nine times.

He has written for and taught many mass bands including the opening and closing of the Los Angeles Olympics (1984), Centennial of the Statue of Liberty (1986), and the Bicentennial of the French Revolution and the Centennial of the Eiffel Tower in Paris (1989). Lee owns and operates a successful pottery studio in Palm Springs, CA., where he has been an active member of the community for the past 39 years.

Jackie Gilley – Visual Effect



Jackie Gilley is a native of Stratford, Texas, and was the band director at Monroney Middle School in Midwest City, OK., for 29 years. She also taught color guard at Midwest City High School for 18 years. Her first job was in Miami, Texas, teaching art, band, and yearbook. Jackie received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Ceramics and her Masters of Music Education degree from Southwestern Oklahoma State University. She is also accredited in Secondary Education Administration from the University of Central Oklahoma.

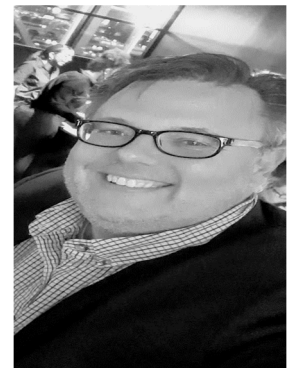
Ms. Gilley earned accreditation in 2002 as a “National Certified Teacher” in Instrumental Music, and she was also “Monroney Teacher of the Year” in 1992 and 2003. In 2012, Jackie was inducted into the Oklahoma Bandmasters Association Hall of Fame. In 2014 she was inducted into the Oklahoma Music Educators Hall of Fame and was awarded “OKMEA Exemplary Teacher” in 2013. She is past president of the Beta Chapter of Phi Beta Mu International Bandmasters Fraternity and also a member of OMEA, OBA, MENC, and WIBDA.

Ms. Gilley is well-known as an adjudicator throughout the United States. She has been an adjudicator for Winter Guard International, Drum Corps International, Bands of America/Music for All, the Texas Color Guard Judges Association, and Oklahoma Music Adjudicators Association. She also judged for Drum Corps Japan and the Calgary Stampede.

Jackie currently serves as a board member of the Stratford Education Foundation, which serves students in the Stratford Independent School District in Texas. She is also certified as an Oklahoma Master Gardener and serves as a tutor for the Whiz Kids reading program.

Christopher Babashka – Field Manager

Chris Babashka has been actively involved in the marching arts for over 34 years; including four years marching in The Big Red Marching Machine at Illinois State University and three years with the Velvet Knights Drum and Bugle Corps from Anaheim, California. Chris is currently an adjudicator and contest director with Bands of America, adjudicator and contest coordinator for The Midwest Color Guard Circuit, and adjudicator at multiple performance arts events across Illinois and the United States. He is also a contest coordinator and event safety manager for Drum Corps International. Chris received a Bachelor of Science degree from Illinois State University in 1995 and a Master of Science degree in 1996. He completed his MBA in healthcare administration from Benedictine University in 2013. In his spare time, he enjoys being retired as a speech pathologist and healthcare leader in Chicago, and most importantly, enjoys spending time with his family and four children.
