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DIRECTORS WITH STUDENTS ATTENDING ALL-STATE CLINICS 2026

NEED THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. Student information packet that includes the Student Code of Conduct Form which **must** be signed by the student and his/her parent(s), and in **your possession** during the conference. Online for download - please **make a copy for each of your students** who will participate in All-State.
Each student must be accompanied by a director or principal-approved responsible adult.
2. All-State Registration Forms available online – Please complete your registration forms by Monday 5:00 p.m. and email it to asboajg@gmail.com. You can request a Square invoice at that time as well. DO NOT MAIL Registration and/or checks.
3. As soon as possible, check the printout very carefully for each of your students and report any problems before **3:00 p.m. on Monday, February 9, 2026.**
 - Remember the high and low individual card totals are deleted from the final total on Oboe, Bassoon, Low Clarinets, all Saxes, Euphonium, Tuba, and band String Bass.
 - On Flute, Bb Clarinet, Trumpet, French Horn, and Tenor & Bass T-Bone, the high & low Scale/SR scores and the high & low Prepared scores are deleted independently. You will have a printout for each room plus a summary sheet for split rooms indicating the sum of the scores that counted in **both** rooms as the final score.
 - On Percussion, the high and low scores for each instrument (audition room) are deleted independently – the sum of the scores that counted in all 3 rooms is the final score.
 - All three judges' scores count for Jazz and for Orchestra.
4. Please make sure that your students and parents are aware that the results are not final until Monday, February 9 at 5:00 p.m.
5. Updated Conference Schedule, Clinic and Conference Registration Forms, and Student packets are online.

If a student has qualified for **Jazz Band, Concert Band, Choir and/or Symphonic Orchestra**, complete that student's information on the Google form found at www.ASBOA.org so that we may make the shifts in personnel due to student choices.

The form MUST be submitted by 3:00 p.m. Monday, February 9.

Updated rosters with final student choices and adjustments will be posted Tuesday, February 10, noon.

The rosters for all All-State groups must be at the printer by 7:00 a.m., Wednesday, February 11. These rosters will be used for T-shirts and programs. The printer is graciously rushing this process so that students, directors, and parents will have the souvenir program.

The ASBOA office must know which group your students have chosen by Monday, February 9 at 3:00 p.m.

If you feel there is a problem with information on the score sheet you receive, please fax it to 501.421.7994 with an explanation of the problem by Monday, February 9 at 5:00 p.m.

(The Arkansas Activities Association requires that a certified teacher or a responsible adult, authorized in writing by the school, accompany the student)

This CODE OF CONDUCT is issued in keeping with the goal of providing the finest musical experience possible for members of the All-State Music organizations. No student will be allowed to participate in an All-State organization without completing this form and returning it to his/her director before the conference. The directors will be responsible for having these forms with them at the conference.

1. Students are responsible for all their own personal possessions - jewelry, instruments, equipment, etc.
2. Students must remain reasonably quiet at all times in the hotel. TVs, phones, music, and other electronic devices must remain at low volume levels.
3. No student will leave the hotel without proper adult supervision.
4. No items may be charged to the room (room service, phone calls, etc.)
5. Room check will begin at 10:45 PM. The All-State curfew is at 11:00 PM. Students must be in their own rooms at this time and must not leave their rooms after this time except in cases of emergency.
6. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances (drugs or illegal materials) will not be tolerated.
7. Prompt attendance at all rehearsals and performances is mandatory. Tardiness will not be tolerated.
8. Students are expected to be on their best behavior at all times. Inappropriate behavior in and outside of rehearsals will not be tolerated.
9. Students are under all ArkCDA, ASBOA, AAA, Music Conference, and individual school policies.
10. Students will notify their directors and/or chaperones if they become ill and will physically distance themselves from other students until they've been cleared to return.
