MR. LEO KUCINSKI

Leo Kucinski was born in Warsaw, Poland. He received his education at Oberlin College, the Cleveland Institute of Music, and was a Graduate Fellow at the Juillard Graduate School of Music.

Mr. Kucinski is presently conductor of the Sioux City Symphony Orchestra and the Sioux Falls, South Dakota, Symphony Orchestra. He has made guest appearances with the Omaha, Minneapolis, El Pass, Cedar Rapids, Duluth, Bridgeport, Shreveport and Guadalajara, Mexico, Symphonies. Mr. Kucinski was conductor of the Lincoln, Nebraska, Symphony Orchestra from 1934 to 1942.

Well known in all parts of the country for his appearances as clinician and festival director, he has conducted workshops at the University of Kansas, the University of Iowa, the University of South Dakota, Madison College in Virginia and Bemidji State College, Minnesota.

He holds the honorary degree of Doctor of Music given him at Morning-side College, Sioux City, Iowa.
