## 2004 All-State Clinicians

### DR. JACKIE LAMAR – University of Central Arkansas - Second All-State Jazz Band

Jackie Lamar is Professor of Music at the University of Central Arkansas where she teaches saxophone and conducts jazz and saxophone ensembles. She holds the Doctorate of Musical Arts in Saxophone Performance and Master of Music Education from the University of North Texas, and the Bachelor of Music Education from the University of Central Arkansas. Her principal teachers have been Debra Richtmeyer, Jim Riggs, and Homer Brown. Dr. Lamar has performed at three World Saxophone Congresses and at many regional and national conferences of the North American Saxophone Alliance. She currently serves as Region Four Director of NASA and as State Unit Secretary of the International Association of Jazz Educators. Other professional memberships include Phi Beta Mu, Arkansas School Band and Orchestra Association, Arkansas Bandmasters Association, and Tau Beta Sigma Alumni.

### TERELL STAFFORD – Temple University – All-State First Jazz Band

Born in Miami to musically inclined parents, Terell Stafford picked up his first trumpet at the age of thirteen. Growing up in Chicago and later in Silver Spring, Maryland, Terell studied classical music, but was always drawn to jazz. While he pursued a degree in Music Education at the University of Maryland, Stafford played with the school's jazz band. He began to immerse himself in jazz, listening to everything he could get his hands on. "One of my first and most profound musical influences was and is Clifford Brown," notes Terell. "When I first heard him play 'Cherokee' I was in total awe of his playing." In 1988, Terell had the good fortune to meet and talk with trumpeter Wynton Marsalis, who suggested that Stafford study with Dr. William Fielder at Rutgers University. Soon after, Terell entered the Masters Program at Rutgers, where he received his Graduate Degree in Music Performance in 1993. He is currently full-time Associate Professor of Jazz Studies at Temple University in Philadelphia, the prestigious Vail Foundation in Colorado and Jazz at Lincoln Center's Essentially Ellington Program. He also served as a member of the faculty for the Juilliard Institute for Jazz Studies in New York.

### BRETT WALLACE – Northeastern State University Oklahoma – All-State Orchestra

Brett Wallace has been a music teacher in Boulder Colorado since 1980. He directs the Fairview High School Chamber Strings as well as orchestras at Southern Hills Middle School and 5 elementaries. Mr. Wallace has had a number of groups who have been issued invitations to perform at the annual Colorado Music Educators Association Clinic/Conference. His groups have performed in France, Belgium, Holland, England, Germany, the Bahamas, Italy, and Austria. Mr. Wallace is in high demand throughout the state and region as a guest conductor, judge and clinician. As a professional cellist, he is at home on the stage, in the classroom, and in the recording studio. He is an active freelancer and has performed with the Denver Chamber Orchestra, Opera Colorado, and the Colorado Ballet Orchestra. His degrees include a Bachelor of Music Education and Master of Music in Orchestral Conducting from the University of Colorado. Mr. Wallace and his wife, Stephanie, are in their 13th season as musical directors and conductors of the 180 member Front Range Youth Symphonies. In 1998 Mr. Wallace was selected "Colorado String Educator of the Year," and is listed in "Who's Who Among America's Teachers."

### DR. KEN VAN WINKLE – New Mexico State University – All-State Concert Band

Ken Van Winkle is Director of Bands at New Mexico State University. He is a graduate of West Texas A&M University, the University of North Texas, and received his Doctorate of Musical Arts in trumpet from the University of Oregon. Dr. Van Winkle co-directs the NMSU "Pride" marching band and also teaches conducting. He performs in the NMSU faculty brass quintet, the Quintessential Brass Quintet of El Paso, Texas and is active as an adjudicator, conductor, and band clinician throughout the Southwest. His professional memberships include College Band Directors National Association, the International Trumpet Guild, and National Band Association. He is actively involved in public school music as a member and past president of the New Mexico Music Educators Association.

### ROBERT W. SMITH – Warner Brothers – All-State Symphonic Band

Robert W. Smith (b. 1958) is one of the most popular and prolific composers of concert band and orchestral literature in America today. He has over 500 publications in print with the majority composed and arranged through his long association with Warner Bros. Publications. His compositions and arrangements have been used in a variety of situations his music is widely accepted by all ages. Mr. Smith's credits include many compositions and productions in all areas of the music field. His original works for winds and percussion have been programmed by countless military, university, high school, and middle school bands throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, South America and Asia. As a conductor and clinician, Mr. Smith has performed throughout the United States, Canada, Japan, Europe and Australia. In addition, he has been awarded numerous commissions from professional and school ensembles throughout the United States, Canada Europe and Korea. He has recently released "Inchon: The Symphonic Music of Robert W. Smith Volume 2", the second in a series of compact disc recordings of his best-known works for concert band. In addition, he is co-creator of the Expressions Music Curriculum, a comprehensive Pre-K through 12 music program written for school systems worldwide

#### **GLEND A CASEY – Denison, Texas – All-State Male Chorus**

A native of Dallas, Texas, Glenda Casey earned her Bachelor of Music and Master of Music Education from Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas. She received her Texas Professional Supervision certificate in 1986 and has completed all course work toward a doctorate degree in Secondary and Higher Education from Texas A & M University in Commerce, Texas. Glenda completed her 30<sup>th</sup> year of teaching in the Texas Public School System in May 2000. Her last teaching position was at Berkner High School in the Richardson Independent School District where she served as choral director for 19 years. Her choirs were consistently awarded Sweepstakes in the University Interscholastic League competitions, were selected to perform for the Texas Music Educators Association conventions, and were recognized as Best-in-Class in music festivals throughout Texas, in California, and in Florida. Glenda is co-author of Essential Elements for Choir which is a nationally distributed textbook written for choral music students in grades 7 through 12 published by Hal Leonard Corporation in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Professional affiliations include the Texas Music Educators Association, Texas Choral Directors Association, Texas Music Adjudicators Association, American Choral Directors Association, Arizona Music Educators Association, Arizona Choral Directors Association and Music Educators National Conference. Jim and Glenda moved back “home” to Texas in June, 2003. Glenda continues to serve as an adjudicator for choral contests and festivals, workshop presenter for music educators, and choral clinician/conductor for region, honor, and all-state choirs throughout Texas and the ACDA Southwestern Division.

#### **Dr. Donald Bailey – Baylor University – All-State Female Chorus**

Dr. Donald Bailey is the Director of Choral Activities and the Mary Gibbs Jones Professor of Music at Baylor University where he conducts the A Cappella Choir, Chamber Singers, and teaches choral conducting. Prior to coming to Baylor University in 1993, he held similar positions at Arizona State University, Texas Tech University, Houghton College, and Eastern New Mexico University. He received his Bachelor of Music Education summa cum laude and Master of Arts in Vocal Performance degrees from Eastern New Mexico University and his Doctor of Arts in Conducting from the University of Northern Colorado. Dr. Bailey was recently named an "Outstanding Alumnus" by the University of Northern Colorado for his contributions to music. He currently serves as the President of the Texas Choral Directors Association. Particularly active as a guest conductor and clinician, he has conducted over three hundred and fifty clinics in the last ten years. He frequently appears as an All State Clinician having conducted All State Choirs in Alabama, Colorado, Delaware, Montana, New Mexico, New York, Tennessee, and Texas. He has appeared as a guest conductor at both Carnegie Hall and Avery Fisher Hall in Lincoln Center. An active composer, Dr. Bailey is represented by Alliance Music Publications and Gentry Publications. He is currently is the Conductor of the Schola Cantorum of Texas.

#### **DR. JANET GALVAN – Ithaca College – All-State Mixed Choir**

Dr. Janet Galván, Professor of Music at Ithaca College, conducts the Ithaca College Women's Chorale, the Ithaca College Chorus, and is Artistic Director for the Ithaca Children's Choir. Dr. Galván's contribution to choral music was recognized by her New York colleagues in 1995 when she received the New York Outstanding Choral Director Award. In great demand as a guest conductor, Dr. Galván has conducted all-state and larger regional honor choral festivals throughout the United States. Dr. Galván is also the conductor of the North American Children's Chorale which performs annually in Carnegie Hall. Her own choral groups have been chosen to perform at national, regional, and state professional music conferences as well as many invitational choral festivals. Dr. Galván is on the artistic staff of Choral Music Experience founded by Dr. Doreen Rao. Her expertise in treble repertoire led to an association with Roger Dean Publishing Company in the origin of the Janet Galván Women's Choir Series and Roots and Wings, a series for young voices. She is the series advisor to Latin Accents, a series with Boosey & Hawkes. As a soloist, Dr. Galván has performed leading soprano roles with the Ithaca Opera Company. She was been a member of the Grammy Award-winning Robert Shaw Festival Chorus during Mr. Shaw's final years. Dr. Galván has honored to be profiled in Outstanding Young Women of America, Who's Who In the East, and International Biographies of Women.
