## 2006 All-State Clinicians

### GARY MEGGS – University of Arkansas Monticello – Second Jazz Band



Gary Meggs currently works as the director of bands and saxophone teacher at the University of Arkansas as Monticello. He earned his Bachelor and Masters degree in Music Education. He has formerly directed bands for 21 years in the public schools of Texas. Mr. Meggs is an active member in numerous organizations inclusive of Arkansas Bandmaster's Association, Arkansas School Band and Orchestra Association, International Association of Jazz Educators, College Band Director National Association and Phi Beta Mu.

In addition to his teaching career, Mr. Meggs performs nationally and is a successful Christian songwriter. His group "The Ezekiel 3:18 Band" has been in the Christian charts for the past two years. He has been a guest artist with the 8<sup>th</sup> Air Force Jazz Band, Air Force Band of the West and toured in South America with the 531<sup>st</sup> Air Force Band. He is a retired member of the 106<sup>th</sup> Army Band in Little Rock, Arkansas. Mr. Meggs lives in Monticello, Arkansas, with his wife, Debbie, and his mom, Sudie.

### JOE ECKERT – Shenandoah University – First Jazz Band



Joe Eckert is currently Associate Professor of Saxophone and Director of Jazz Studies at Shenandoah University in Winchester, Virginia. He recently retired from a 20-year career as lead alto saxophonist/woodwind specialist and director for the USAF Band Airmen of Note in Washington, D.C.

Mr. Eckert received his B.M. from Baldwin-Wallace College and completed graduate and post-graduate studies at the University of North Texas. Prior to joining the Airmen of Note, he was Assistant Professor of Saxophone and Director of Jazz Studies at West Virginia University in Morgantown, WV, where he received the "Outstanding Teacher Award" for 1982-83. As producer for the "Jazz Heritage Concert Series," he collaborated with some of the great names in jazz. As coordinator of the "Jazz Outreach Education Series," he brought the expertise of Airmen of Note to aspiring music students throughout the country.

After serving as adjunct faculty since 1987, Mr. Eckert joined the faculty full-time upon his retirement from active duty in the fall of 2004. Mr. Eckert is currently an educational specialist for the Conn-Selmer Corporation and is President-Elect of the Virginia chapter of IAJE.

### JACK RANNEY – University of Illinois Urbana – Orchestra



Jack Ranney taught in Kirksville, MO (1961-1963) and in Ottumwa, IA (1963-69) where he served as a public school string teacher and orchestra director. While teaching in Ottumwa, he received the Outstanding Young Educator Award which was given by the Jaycee organization. In 1969, he started teaching in the Cedar Rapids, IA, school district. He was also conductor for the Cedar Rapids and Iowa City Youth Symphonies and the Coe College Orchestra. Washington High School in Cedar Rapids honored him by electing him to the Performing Arts Hall of Fame in 1999. In 1980, he accepted a position at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign where he served as the coordinator of string programs for the School of Music, Office of Continuing Education and Public Service in Music. Ranney also serves as the conductor of the Parkland College Orchestra in Champaign, IL as well as the conductor for the Champaign-Urbana Symphony Orchestra Young People's Concerts.

Mr. Ranney received his Bachelor and Masters degrees from Northeast Missouri State University in Kirksville, MO, and did advanced violin study at the University of Iowa. In September of 2005, he retired from the University of Illinois and continues to be active as a guest conductor and string clinician.

### JAY GEPHART – Purdue University – Concert Band



Jay S. Gephart joined the faculty of Purdue University in the fall of 1995 after having completed 12 years as a public school band director. Professor Gephart serves as Director of the Purdue University Symphonic Band and Symphony Orchestra, coordinator of the concert band program and music director for the orchestra program. In addition, Professor Gephart also serves as Artistic Administrator for the Lafayette Symphony Orchestra.

Mr. Gephart received a Master of Music Degree in Performance with High Distinction from Indiana University in 1988 and a Bachelor of Music Education Degree with Distinction from Indiana University in 1983. He taught in the public schools in Georgia, Illinois and Indiana. In 1998, Professor Gephart received the "New Professional Award" for his outstanding work in Purdue Bands. In 2001, he was recognized with the Indiana Outstanding Bandmaster Award by the Gamma Chapter of Phi Beta Mu and currently serves on the board of directors for the Indiana Chapter of Phi Beta Mu. He and his wife, Carolyn, have three daughters and one son. The Gepharts reside in Lafayette, Indiana.

### RICHARD BLATTI – Ohio State University – Symphonic Band



Associate Professor Richard Blatti currently serves the Ohio State University as Head of the Ensembles and Conducting Area and as Associate Director of Bands. Professor Blatti is the only person to have twice received the Ohio State University School of Music Distinguished Teaching Award in 1991 and in 2001. Prior to his appointment at OSU, Professor Blatti was Associate Professor of Music at Albion College in Michigan, where he served as Director of Instrumental Music, Coordinator of the chamber music program and supervisor of the instrumental music education program. During his ten years on the Albion Faculty, Mr. Blatti was twice selected the outstanding Faculty Member of the Year.

He received his bachelor and master degrees from Northwestern University, has done postgraduate work at Michigan State University and has taught in public schools and at the university level in Illinois, Michigan and Ohio for over 25 years. In 2003, Professor Blatti was named the Conductor Laureate of the Heisey Wind Ensemble, a well-established adult community band affiliated with Denison University. He was inducted into the prestigious American Bandmasters Association in 1997 and continues to be a leader in the College Band Directors National Association, the Big Ten Band Directors Association and the Ohio Music Educators Association.

**DR. BEN AYLING – Kent State University – Male Chorus**



Ben Ayling has been the choral music education specialist at Kent State since the fall of 2002. He has served as a clinician at music educator's conferences throughout the United States, Canada, England, New Zealand, Australia and Russia. With special interests in choral techniques and sight-singing, his research agenda includes the areas of pitch perception and cognition.

Dr. Ayling's choirs are consistently known for their high standards. His ensembles have toured throughout the Midwest and Eastern United States as well as Belgium and The Netherlands. He is the founder and conductor of the KSU Men's Chorus which debuted in the fall of 2002 and has served as the interim director of the KSU Chorale.

**AMY ALLIBON – Haltom High School, Fort Worth – Women's Choir**



Amy Allibon has taught secondary choral music in Texas for 17 years at both the middle school and high school levels. She is currently director of choirs at Haltom High School in Haltom City, Texas where she leads 250 students in 11 performing ensembles. The 2002 Haltom High School Teacher of the Year, Ms. Allibon is a frequent clinician and adjudicator throughout the country.

Ms. Allibon recently served a two-year term as the High School/College Vice-President of the Texas Choral Directors Association. She is a co-author of Choral Expressions, a choral music textbook series for the secondary classrooms to be published by Alfred Publishing. Ms. Allibon holds a Bachelors of Music Education degree from Texas Christian University and a Masters of Music in Choral Conducting from Texas Tech University. She resides in Fort Worth with her husband, Rob.

**ROBERT TAYLOR – College of Charleston – Mixed Choir Director**



Robert Taylor is Director of Choral Activities at the College of Charleston, the Director of the Charleston Symphony Orchestra Chorus and the CSO Chamber Singers. Dr. Taylor is the founding Artistic Director of the Taylor Music Festival and Festival Choir, a summer festival named after and in honor of his deceased father, Bob Taylor, an Arkansas high school choral conductor of distinction for over 25 years. Dr. Taylor's ensembles have performed throughout the U.S. and Europe, including the 2005 American Choral Directors Association National Convention in Los Angeles, CA., and annual appearances in Spoleto USA and the Piccolo Spoleto Festival.

Dr. Taylor holds a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Choral Conducting degree from Louisiana State University, a Masters of Music in Vocal Performance from Sam Houston State University, and a Bachelor in Music Education degree from the University of Central Arkansas.
