

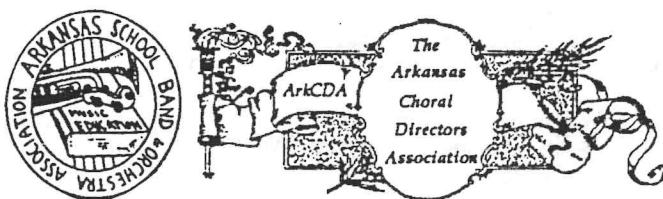

A Million Suns At Midnight - Text by Kevin Dunlop and Steven Bryant (Notes by Steven Bryant)

Though somewhat dark and dramatic in character, *A Million Suns At Midnight* is ultimately a hopeful, optimistic work, evoking the struggles of humanity to grow, achieve, and evolve, finally overcoming our fear (and its most common manifestation: violence: to transcend our physical and mental boundaries. The arrival of the year 2000 is a potent marker for this transcendence. The pace of societal and technological evolution in the world is accelerating exponentially, and we seem to be on the threshold of truly revolutionary changes in the way the human species exists, from genetic manipulation, to nanotechnology, to computers powerful enough to be called conscious (projected by some to occur by the year 2020). When the ability to either provide food and shelter for every person on the planet, or destroy the planet altogether, is available to common individuals, we must all become *more* than common individuals. We must ensure that the million suns at midnight are not those of fiery destruction, but of a bright hope.

Note: The text is presented as it occurs in the music, with phrases repeated as they are in the piece. Since this text has never existed apart from the music, there is no definitive version of it in poetic form. Italics indicate whispered words and [brackets] indicate lines that occur simultaneously or contrapuntally with the adjacent text.

Steven Bryant (b. 1972) was born in Little Rock, Arkansas. He studied composition with John Corigliano at the Julliard School, Cindy McTee at the University of North Texas, and Francis McBeth at Ouachita University. Mr. Bryant has written several pieces for wind ensemble, an orchestral work, some electronic and electro-acoustic music, and a few chamber works. Mr. Bryant's, *Chester Leaps In*, recorded by the Rutgers Univ. Wind Ensemble and the Univ. of Nevada, Las Vegas Wind Symphony, has been performed throughout the United States and Japan. Other works include *Redline*, *Monkey*, *The Wilding*, *Overtures Interruptus*, and *Dancing Around the Cathode Campfire*.

Mr. Bryant has collaborated with choreographers in Texas and New York, produced multimedia projects at Julliard, and created interactive computer music pieces using the MAX programming environment. He lives in New York City and works at The Julliard School where he provides instruction and assistance in computers and music technology.

Kevin Dunlop is currently stationed at Maxwell AFB in Montgomery, Alabama.

CHRIS VADALA, First All-State Jazz Band Clinician, is one of the country's foremost woodwind artists, and is in demand as a jazz/classical performer and educator. Professor Vadala is currently Director of Jazz Studies and Saxophone Professor at the University of Maryland, as well as adjunct faculty at Montgomery College in saxophone and jazz studies. He has appeared on more than ninety recordings to date, as well as innumerable jingle sessions, film and TV scores, performing on all the saxophones, flutes, and clarinets. A native of Poughkeepsie, N.Y., he graduated from the Eastman School of Music, earning the honor of the Performer's Certificate in saxophone as well as a BM in Music Education, and received an MA in clarinet from Connecticut College. Mr. Vadala is a clinician for the Selmer Corporation.



PATRICK HASTY, Second All-State Jazz Band Clinician, is an associate professor of music at the University of Central Arkansas. He has taught there since 1965 beginning as the brass teacher and assistant band director. He is now teaching trumpet, jazz ensembles, and jazz history. Mr. Hasty is a charter member of the International Trumpet Guild, a member of the International Association of Jazz Educators, the American Federation of Musicians, as well as MTNA. He has studied at the Univ. of Wisconsin and the Univ. of North Texas where he earned the BME degree, the MM degree in trumpet, and has 60 hours towards the DMA in trumpet. He has performed as a professional trumpet player since his teenage years in Milwaukee and was a member of the "One O'Clock Lab Band" at North Texas.



ROBERT STOVALL, All-State Men's Choir Clinician, is the director of choral activities for the Andrews Independent School District at Andrews, Texas where his teaching responsibilities include conducting the Andrews High School A Capella Choir, the Girl's Chorale, the Men's Chorale, and the show choir, "Black and Gold." He also supervises the choral activities at Andrews Middle School. On the state and national level, Mr. Stovall serves as the Vocal Vice-President of the Texas Music Educators Association as well as the Co-Site Chairman of the Southwest Division of the American Choral Directors Association.



CHARLOTTE ADAMS, All-State Women's Choir Clinician, is music teacher at Cherry Creek High School in Englewood, Colorado. She holds a Bachelor of Arts from Colorado College and a Master of Music degree from Indiana University. She has served as ACDA Southwestern Division Chairperson for Research and Development of Women's Music. Her video, *"Daily Workout for a Beautiful Voice"* was published in the Charlene Archibeque Choral Series. The Charlotte Adams Choral Series is published by Santa Barbara Music Publishing. In 1984, she received the "Choral Director of the Year" Award presented by Colorado ACDA. Ms. Adams was the recipient of the 1991 National Sallie Mae "Teacher Tribute Award" published in *Newsweek*.



DR. KENNETH FULTON, All-State Mixed Choir Clinician, is professor of choral music and chair of the division of ensembles and conducting at the Louisiana State University School of Music in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. He supervises graduate choral studies at LSU and conducts the LSU A Capella Choir, acclaimed as one of the premier collegiate ensembles in the country. He is also Chorus Master and Assistant Conductor for the Baton Rouge Symphony and Symphony Chorus.



RICHARD FUCHS, All-State Orchestra Clinician, is Professor of Violin at the University of Northern Colorado School of Music, and is recognized as an outstanding performer, teacher, conductor and clinician. As a member of the FUCHS DUO, he continues to be heard in recitals on major college and university campuses around the world and is frequently invited to perform at conventions such as MTNA and the Society of American Composers. As a noted teacher, Fuchs specializes in the "use of natural body motions and body rhythm" which was cultivated through his studies with famed violin pedagogue, Paul Rolland. Fuchs is frequently invited to conduct All-State and music camp orchestras and to lecture on various pedagogical approaches and string strategies.



RAY C. LICHTENWALTER, All-State Concert Band Clinician, is Director of Bands and Conductor of the Wind Ensemble at the University of Texas at Arlington. He is a graduate of Lebanon Valley College, Annville, Pennsylvania, and the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor. Mr. Lichtenwalter also serves as the Artistic Director and Conductor of the Texas Wind Symphony. As a proponent of quality literature for the wind band, he has been responsible for numerous commissions and premiers of wind literature by significant contemporary composers. He holds membership in the American Bandmasters Association, Phi Beta Mu, College Band Directors National Association, Texas Music Educators Association and the Texas Bandmasters Association. Mr. Lichtenwalter maintains an active schedule as a clinician, conductor and adjudicator.



GARY D. GREEN, All-State Symphonic Band Clinician, is Professor of Music and Director of Bands at the University of Miami, conducts the Wind Ensemble and is also conductor of the University Symphonic Band. Besides being responsible for all band activities at UM, he is also Chairman of Instrumental Performance and is a member of the Clinics Committee of the Florida Bandmasters Association. Gary Green has been influential in the commissioning and recording of many new works for the Wind and Percussion medium. Mr. Green is a member of the American Bandmasters Association, the College Band Directors National Association, the Music Educators National Conference, the Florida Bandmasters Association and the Florida Music Educators National Conference. Throughout his career, Mr. Green has received numerous honors and awards. He has conducted International, National and Regional Honor bands and Intercollegiate Bands in most of the fifty states.
